WRITTEN RECORD - National Electrical Code, Article 700-4.

- 1) BATTERY ELECTROLYTE LEVEL For units with refillable battery(s) DO NOT PRESS TEST SWITCH IF ELECTROLYTE LEVEL IS BELOW BOTTOM ADD WATER FILL LINE. Check electrolyte level add distilled water if necessary, but do not fill above top electrolyte line. Indicate O.K. or ADD in maintenance log column.
 - 2) EMERGENCY OPERATION Depress test switch for 60–90 seconds to simulate power failure. This illuminates the emergency lamp head(s) and turns off the indicator light(s). Indicate O.K. on log card if lamp head(s) and indicator light(s) are operating properly.
 - 3) CHARGING OPERATION Release test switch. The emergency lamp head(s) will turn off and the indicator light(s) will come on to indicate "AC ON". For units with rate of charge indicator, the unit will read a fast rate of charge for 5–10 minutes and slowly diminish and stabilize to a trickle charge indication. Indicate O.K. on log card if unit is operating properly.
 - 4) CORRECTIVE ACTION Report any inoperational features to supervision and record yes in column.

DISCONNECT FROM NORMAL POWER SUPPLY SOURCE AND DISCONNECT BATTERY IF NOT OPERATING PROPERLY. REMOVE THE BATTERY FROM THE CASE WHEN THE UNIT IS TO BE MOVED FOR ANY REASON.
